

# Cornerstone 2018 Summer Mission Trip

## Yakama Indian Reservation

### White Swan, WA

- When:** July 14-21, 2018. We will fly into Seattle, WA on Saturday, July 14th and fly back on Saturday, July 22nd.
- Where:** Yakama Indian Reservation – just outside of Yakima, WA; 3 hours southeast of Seattle.
- What:** Cornerstone Presbyterian Church is teaming up with Sacred Road Ministries (a PCA church and mission) - [www.sacredroadministries.com](http://www.sacredroadministries.com) for a mission trip to the Yakama Indian Reservation in Washington state. Construction/clean up in mornings – VBS/back-yard Bible club in afternoons.
- Who:** Adults and families (children 13 & 14 must come with a parent). Space is limited to 20 spots! Spots will be filled on a first-come- first-serve basis with a \$100 deposit!
- Why:** To support our ministry partners the Grandberrys and Sacred Road Ministries. To go and serve the Lord in another land. To grow personally through missions. To see what God is doing among the Native American people. To discover if God maybe calling you to missions in some way.
- Cost:** Approximately \$1000 to raise (includes \$100 deposit). \$500 airfare\*, \$375/person Sacred Road, \$125 activity and transportation cost. *\*Subject to change when final flight fees are secured.*

**How do I reserve a spot? A spot is ONLY reserved with:**

- 2) a completed mission trip application: *will be emailed to you*
- 3) a \$100 deposit.\* Make checks out to Cornerstone Presbyterian Church with memo of Yakama 2018 trip. *\*If you pay a deposit you are committing to the trip. We will be buying you a plane ticket and you will be responsible for the cost of the plane ticket if you cancel. Please read the Participant Financial Commitment on back.*

## **Commitments for being on a short-term mission team:**

- Keep up with correspondence by email regarding the trip
- write team support letters
- Per the application, participants are responsible for raising the entire amount
- Attend ALL team meetings and support raising opportunities
- Be regularly involved in church activities
- Pray, pray, pray!

\*If you pay a deposit you are committing to the trip. We will be buying you a plane ticket and you will be responsible for the cost of the plane ticket if you cancel. If for providential reasons you must cancel, we will strive to fill your spot and at that time we may be able to reimburse you for the deposit. All funds raised after the deposit will be tax deductible gifts to Cornerstone Presbyterian Church on your behalf – therefore they are not refundable.

### **Participant Financial Commitment for Short-Term Mission Trips Sponsored by Cornerstone Presbyterian Church**

All participants are required to pay a non-refundable and non-transferable deposit. The deposit amount shall be set by missions committee and shall not exceed the per-person amount designated by the partnering mission organization. (Example: \$100/person deposit to Sacred Road Ministries per their guidelines).

By paying a deposit for the trip you are assuming financial responsibility for the trip and are authorizing Cornerstone Presbyterian Church to purchase airfare on your behalf. Accordingly if you do not go on the trip and the airline ticket cannot be transferred to another person you will be responsible to pay the cost of the ticket to CPC.

Furthermore, if for any reason the trip is cancelled, any expenses incurred will first be deducted against contributions raised. No contributions given to the church will be returned, but will be kept in an account for use on a future approved trip. All funds raised after the deposit will be tax deductible gifts to Cornerstone Presbyterian Church on your behalf – therefore they are not refundable.

If the trip is canceled, all funds raised will be kept as short-term missions tax-deductible contributions and a record of the funds you raised will be kept for a mission trip.p
